Graduate Certificates in Arts and Sciences

Graduate certificates in the College of Arts and Sciences are designed to complement a student's graduate program or enhance relevant knowledge in an area of study. The certificate is a flexible program that provides students with breadth of knowledge and the challenge of working outside their home discipline in concentrated interdisciplinary study. CERTIFICATE IN AFRICANA STUDIES

The graduate certificate in Africana Studies is designed as a complement to a graduate program (e.g. English, History, Political Science) or as a standalone post-baccalaureate course of study.
