Work-study jobs are available throughout the university and are funded through federal and university sources. All work-study positions are posted on Handshake. Upon securing a work study job and completing all of the necessary paperwork, you will be paid on a bi-weekly basis, as you work and submit timesheets. Work-study earnings are not deducted from your billed expenses.
